

STATEMENT TO
ASSEMBLY, No. 325

with Senate Floor Amendments
(Proposed by Senator DIEGNAN)

ADOPTED: OCTOBER 17, 2022

This floor amendment specifies that in order for a member of the Armed Forces of the United States who is not domiciled in this State, the member's spouse, and any of the member's dependents, to drive in this State, the driver's license they possess must be valid in the person's state of domicile.
