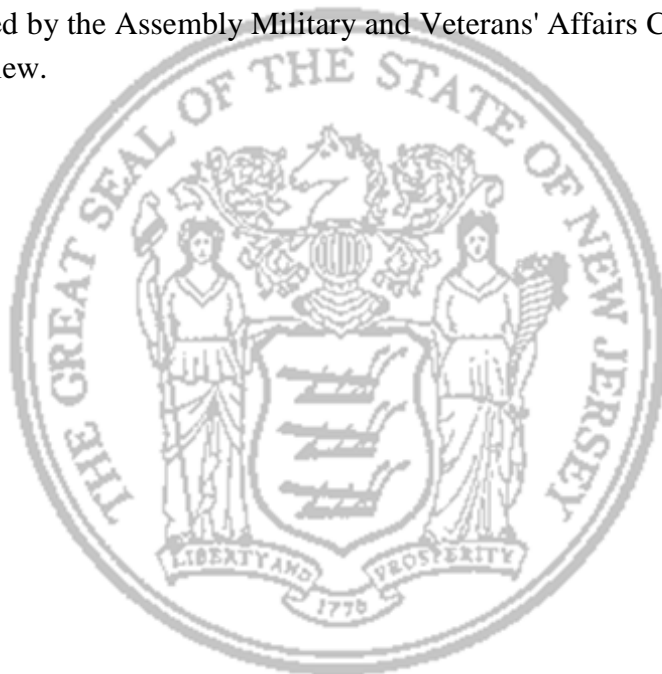

Authorizes military service members, spouses, and dependents with out-of-state domicile to operate motor vehicles in New Jersey.

1 AN ACT concerning authorization to operate motor vehicles in New
2 Jersey and supplementing Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, rule, or
8 regulation to the contrary, a member of the Armed Forces of the
9 United States who is not domiciled in this State, the member's
10 spouse, and any of the member's dependents may operate a motor
11 vehicle on the public roadways of this State, provided that:

12 a. the person possesses a driver's license issued by the person's
13 state of domicile; and

14 b. the license authorizes the person to operate the same class of
15 vehicle in the person's state of domicile that the person operates in
16 this State.

18 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
