Exempts experienced firefighters from certain requirements.

1 **AN ACT** concerning firefighters and supplementing Title 40A of the
2 New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. A fire department or force, whether paid, part-paid, or
8 volunteer, shall not prohibit a firefighter who has five or more years
9 of experience in fire suppression, firefighting, or fire rescue from
10 engaging in fire suppression, firefighting, or fire rescue solely on
11 the grounds that the firefighter is uncertified or does not meet a
12 requirement that is not imposed pursuant to statute, rule, or
13 regulation.

15 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
