- 1. The Commissioner of Community Affairs, in consultation with the Commissioner of Corrections, shall promulgate rules and regulations, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), that establish standards for prisoner reentry transitional housing supported by public funds.
- 12 The regulations shall establish standards for the following:
 - a. ensuring the physical safety of the residents;
 - b. providing emergency and longer-term housing;
 - counseling and support services to assist residents successfully transition back into the community, including substance abuse treatment, medical services, independent living skills training, education, career development, family services, and recreation;
 - d. personalized care management, including targeted care for residents who served long terms of incarceration; and
 - assisting residents obtain permanent housing.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.
