The required number of specific credit hours in veterinary 9 science/technology, animal science technology, zoology, biology, animal husbandry, or related fields at an accredited college or 10 university shall be no greater than 12 hours for any job title of 11 Animal Health Technician within the civil service. 12 13 b. An applicant with five years of experience in the veterinary technician field in a veterinary hospital, veterinary practice, humane 14 15 society, or other similar place of work where animals are cared for 16 or kept and who does not meet all of the education requirements 17 shall be eligible for the Animal Health Technician job title. 18 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 19
