The Senate Health, Human Services and Senior Citizens Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 3211.

This bill which is designated as the “New Jersey Feminine Hygiene Products for the Homeless Act,” provides that emergency shelters for the homeless that provide services to female residents will be required, within the limits of available funds, to make feminine hygiene products, including, but not limited to, sanitary napkins, tampons, and panty liners, available free of charge to females residing in the shelter.

As reported by the committee, Assembly Bill No. 3211 is identical to Senate Bill No. 2302, which was also reported by the committee on this date.
