SYNOPSIS

Allows individuals that have undergone certain background checks, including individuals with certain commercial driver license endorsements, to renew license online or by mail.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As reported by the Senate Transportation Committee with technical review.



1 AN ACT concerning the renewal of certain driver licenses and
2 supplementing Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. An individual possessing a valid driver license pursuant to
8 the provisions of R.S.39:3-10 and valid commercial driver license
9 pursuant to the provisions of the “New Jersey Commercial Driver
10 License Act,” P.L.1990, c.103 (C.39:3-10.9 et seq.) who also
11 possesses either a federal Transportation Worker Identification
12 Credential, issued by the federal Transportation Security
13 Administration; or a commercial driver license endorsement for the
14 transport of hazardous materials, which includes fingerprinting and
15 background check requirements to be conducted by federal
16 Transportation Security Administration, shall be allowed to renew
17 the individual’s existing driver license and commercial driver
18 license as a REAL-ID compliant version of each of those licenses
19 by mail or through the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission
20 Internet website and shall not be required to renew in-person at a
21 commission agency.

23 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
