The Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 3075.

This bill extends the expiration date for the authorization to conduct games through the Internet to 2033. Under current law, the authorization for Internet gaming is set to expire in November 2023, 10 years following the enactment of the original authorization.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Office of Legislative Services estimates that this bill will result in the continued receipt of Internet gaming tax revenues by the State, the Casino Reinvestment Development Authority, and Atlantic City through November 2033.
