The Senate Transportation Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 3081.

As reported, this bill clarifies that former members of a military reserve unit who completed at least six years of service with a military reserve unit are not required to surrender special license plates, issued to them based on their membership in a military reserve unit, upon being honorably discharged or discharged under general honorable conditions. Currently, members of a military reserve unit are required to surrender special license plates issued to them at the end of their service with the military reserve unit.

As reported, Senate Bill No. 3081 is identical to Assembly Bill No. 4298, which was also reported by the committee on this date.
