**SENATE RESOLUTION No. 103**

The Senate Transportation Committee reports favorably Senate Resolution No. 103.

As reported, this resolution expresses opposition to New York's plans to implement a central business district tolling program, which is commonly referred to as New York's congestion pricing plan. The resolution also urges the Federal Highway Administration to require the inclusion of New Jersey stakeholders in the decision-making process regarding the central business district tolling program prior to the final approval of the program.
