The Senate Transportation Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Senate Joint Resolution No. 14.

As amended and reported, this joint resolution recognizes the third Sunday of November of each year as "World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims" in New Jersey. World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims is an opportunity to raise awareness about the devastation wrought by traffic accidents, educate residents about crash prevention, and honor the emergency response and medical professionals who assist in the aftermath of traffic incidents.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2024-2025 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

These amendments change the date of "World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims" from November 20th of each year to the third Sunday of November of each year.
