SYNOPSIS

Requires compensation for part-time instructional staff at public institutions of higher education to be pro-rated to full-time compensation.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

1 AN ACT concerning part-time instructional staff at public institutions
2 of higher education and supplementing chapter 60 of Title 18A of
3 the New Jersey Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or regulation to the
9 contrary, the compensation for a part-time faculty appointment,
10 including a part-time lecturer or adjunct, at a public institution of
11 higher education shall be calculated pro rata based on the
12 compensation of a comparable full-time position at the institution.

14 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

18

19 This bill requires that the compensation for a part-time faculty
20 appointment, including a part-time lecturer or adjunct, be calculated
21 pro rata based on the compensation of a comparable full-time position
22 at the institution. Many, if not all, public institutions of higher
23 education in this State employ per-course instructors. These
24 instructors deserve equal pay for equal work based on credentials,
25 experience, and work assignments.
