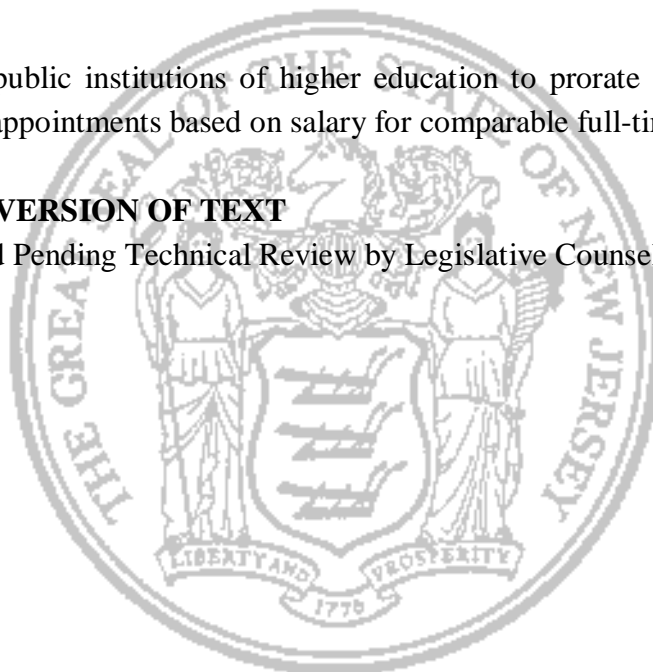

**SYNOPSIS**

Requires public institutions of higher education to prorate salary for part-time faculty appointments based on salary for comparable full-time positions.

1 AN ACT concerning part-time faculty appointments at public  
2 institutions of higher education and supplementing chapter 60 of  
3 Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or regulation to the  
9 contrary, the salary for a part-time faculty appointment at a public  
10 institution of higher education shall be calculated pro rata based on  
11 a comparable full-time position at the institution.

13 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

17

18 This bill requires that the salary for a part-time faculty  
19 appointment at a public institution of higher education be calculated  
20 pro rata based on a comparable full-time position at the institution.  
21 Many, if not all, public institutions of higher education in this State  
22 employ per course instructors. These instructors deserve equal pay  
23 for equal work based on credentials, experience, and work  
24 assignments.
