### **SYNOPSIS**

Decreases rental motor vehicle surcharge from \$5 per day to \$2 per day for temporary replacement rental motor vehicles.

### **CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT**

As introduced.



AN ACT decreasing the rental motor vehicle surcharge from \$5 per day to \$2 per day for temporary replacement rental motor vehicles, amending P.L.2002, c.34.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

- 1. Section 54 of P.L.2002, c.34 (C.App.A:9-78) is amended to read as follows:
- 54. a. As used in this section:

"Rental company" means a person engaged in the business of renting motor vehicles.

"Rental motor vehicle" means a passenger automobile, truck or semitrailer that is rented without a driver and used in the transportation of persons or property other than commercial freight.

"Temporary replacement rental motor vehicle" means a rental motor vehicle that is rented by a rental company at a reduced replacement rate or paid for or reimbursed by an insurance company under replacement coverage when a driver's own motor vehicle is reported to a driver's automobile insurer or to police as stolen or damaged, or taken to a mechanic for repair.

b. Each rental company doing business in this State shall pay a fee for each rental motor vehicle that the company shall have rented from a location in this State under the terms of a rental agreement for a period of not more than 28 days. The amount of the fee shall be \$5 for each day or part thereof that each such vehicle was rented, but shall be \$2 for each day or part thereof that a temporary replacement rental motor vehicles was rented. The fee shall be separately stated to the person to whom the motor vehicle is rented and shall not be included in the receipts subject to the taxes imposed pursuant to the "Sales and Use Tax Act," P.L.1966, c.30 (C.54:32B-1 et seq.).

The director of the Division of Taxation in the Department of the Treasury shall collect and administer the fee; in so doing, the director shall have all the powers granted pursuant to P.L.1966, c.30 (C.54:32B-1 et seq.). The director may, pursuant to the provisions of the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), make, adopt, amend or repeal such rules and regulations as the director finds necessary to carry out the provisions of this subsection.

c. There is established in the General Fund the New Jersey Domestic Security Account, which shall be a dedicated nonlapsing account. Amounts paid to the State Treasurer from the first \$2 of the fee for each day or part thereof that a rental motor vehicle was rented pursuant to subsection b. of this section shall be deposited

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into the account upon receipt. Moneys in the account, including interest thereon, shall be available exclusively for appropriation to support medical emergency disaster preparedness for bioterrorism, security coverage at nuclear power facilities, State Police salaries related to Statewide security services, and counter-terrorism programs.

d. A rental company that rents a temporary replacement rental motor vehicle to a consumer and pays the \$2 per day rate provided pursuant to subsection b. of this section shall verify that the rental is a temporary replacement rental through review of any police report, repair documentation or insurance coverage documentation for a consumer's own motor vehicle and shall, upon request, submit to the director copies of such documentation and such other documentation as the director may require, or follow such other procedure of verification as the director may authorize.

2. This act shall take effect immediately and apply to temporary replacement rentals made on or after the first day of the third month following enactment.

#### **STATEMENT**

This bill reduces the motor vehicle surcharge from \$5 to \$2 for temporary replacement rentals. This decreased surcharge will help drivers save money when they rent motor vehicles out of necessity when they cannot use their own motor vehicles due to damage or breakdown. The rental must be at a reduced replacement rate offered by the rental company or covered by the consumer's automobile insurance in order to qualify for the reduced surcharge. Rental companies will have to collect documentation evidencing the renter's need for a temporary replacement vehicle and provide such documentation to the Director of the Division of Taxation. Acceptable documentation includes police reports, proof of insurance coverage and estimates or receipts from mechanics.
