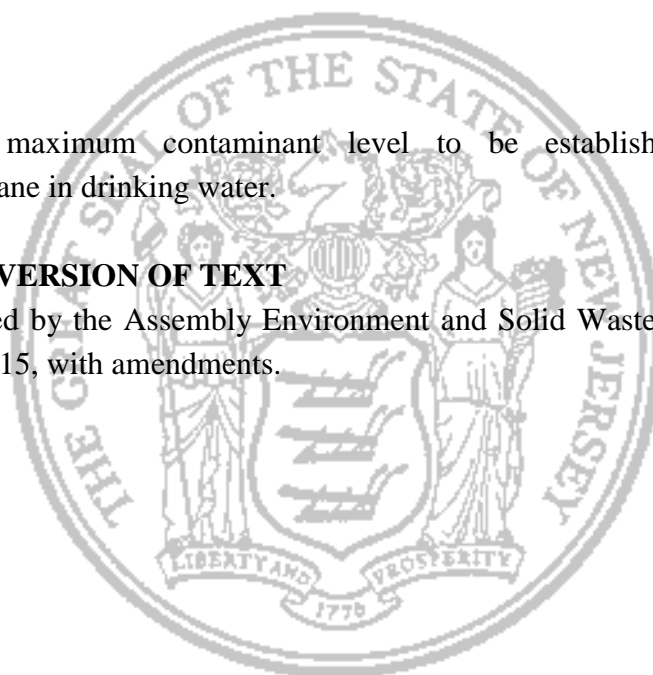

Requires maximum contaminant level to be established for 1,2,3-trichloropropane in drinking water.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As reported by the Assembly Environment and Solid Waste Committee on March 19, 2015, with amendments.

1 AN ACT ¹**[requiring]** concerning¹ a maximum contaminant level
2 ¹**[to be established]**¹ for 1,2,3-trichloropropane and
3 supplementing P.L.1977, c.224 (C.58:12A-1 et seq.).

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:
7

8 1. a. The Drinking Water Quality Institute established pursuant
9 to section 10 of P.L.1983, c.443 (C.58:12A-20) shall ¹study the
10 issue of 1,2,3-trichloropropane levels in drinking water and¹ ,
11 within 90 days after the date of enactment of this act, recommend to
12 the Department of Environmental Protection a maximum
13 contaminant level for 1,2,3-trichloropropane in drinking water ¹**[**,
14 which shall be no more than 0.03 parts per billion¹ **]** .

15 b. The Department of Environmental Protection shall adopt,
16 pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Act,” P.L.1968, c.410
17 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), a maximum contaminant level for 1,2,3-
18 trichloropropane based upon the recommendation made by the
19 Drinking Water Quality Institute pursuant to subsection a. of this
20 section. The department shall adopt the maximum contaminant
21 level for 1,2,3-trichloropropane within 180 days after receiving the
22 recommendation thereon from the institute.

23 ¹**[**c. Until the department adopts a maximum contaminant level
24 for 1,2,3-trichloropropane pursuant to subsection b. of this section,
25 the maximum contaminant level shall be 0.03 parts per billion.¹**]**¹

27 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
