The Assembly Education Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 4190.

This bill stipulates that, for the 2015-2016 through 2017-2018 school years, the assessments developed by the consortium of states known as the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC assessments) may not be used to determine a student's placement in a gifted and talented program, another program or intervention, grade promotion, as the State graduation proficiency test, any other school or district-level decision that affects students, or as part of any evaluation rubric submitted to the Commissioner of Education for approval.
