SYNOPSIS

Phases out State tuition aid grants for students enrolled in proprietary institutions.

1 AN ACT concerning State tuition aid grants and supplementing
2 chapter 71B of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or regulation to
8 the contrary, beginning with the 2014-2015 academic year, a State
9 tuition aid grant for a student enrolled in a proprietary institution
10 licensed to award academic degrees shall be limited to students who
11 received an award prior to that academic year. The student shall be
12 eligible to receive a State tuition aid grant for the number of
13 academic years authorized pursuant to section b. of N.J.S.18A:71B-
14 20.

16 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

21 This bill provides that beginning with the 2014-2015 academic
22 year, a State tuition aid grant for a student enrolled in a proprietary
23 institution will be limited to students who received an award prior
24 that academic year. In effect, the bill initiates a phase-out of State
25 tuition aid grants for students enrolled in proprietary institutions.
26 Students in a proprietary institution who received an award prior to
27 the 2014-2015 academic year will continue to receive an award
28 until they are no longer eligible.
