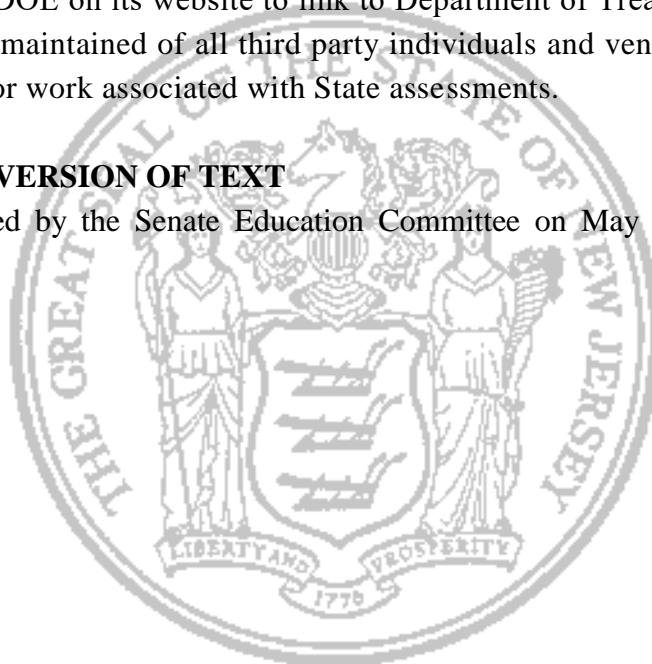

Requires DOE on its website to link to Department of Treasury's website where list is maintained of all third party individuals and vendors employed or retained for work associated with State assessments.

1 AN ACT concerning State assessments and supplementing chapter
2 7C of Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. a. As used in this section, “State assessment” means an
8 assessment required pursuant to State or federal law and
9 administered to all students in a specific grade level or subject area
10 and whose results are aggregated for analysis at the district, school,
11 or student subgroup level.

12 b. The Department of Education shall ¹**[post and regularly**
13 **update]**¹ on its website ¹link to the Department of the Treasury’s
14 website where¹ a list ¹is maintained¹ of all contractors,
15 subcontractors, advisors, or consultants employed or retained by the
16 ¹**[department]** Department of the Treasury¹ for any work associated
17 with the administration, evaluation, monitoring of social media for
18 security breaches, grading, or ongoing development of State
19 assessments.

21 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
