SYNOPSIS

Permits eligible students who are members of United States Armed Forces to wear military uniform at high school graduation.

1 AN ACT concerning high school graduation ceremonies and
2 supplementing chapter 7C of Title 18A of the New Jersey
3 Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. A school district shall allow a student to wear a dress
9 uniform issued to the student by a branch of the United States
10 Armed Forces while participating in the student's high school
11 graduation ceremony, if the following requirements are met:

- 12 a. the student has fulfilled all of the State and local
13 requirements for receiving a high school diploma, and is otherwise
14 eligible to participate in the high school graduation ceremony; and
15 b. the student has completed basic training for, and is an active
16 member of, a branch of the United States Armed Forces.

18 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the third month
19 next following the date of enactment.

22 STATEMENT

24 This bill requires school districts to allow eligible students to
25 wear a dress uniform issued by the United States Armed Forces
26 while participating in their high school graduation ceremony.
27 Under the bill, a student will be permitted to wear a dress uniform
28 at graduation if: (1) the student has fulfilled all State and local
29 requirements for receiving a high school diploma and is otherwise
30 eligible to participate in the high school graduation ceremony; and
31 (2) the student has completed basic training for, and is an active
32 member of, a branch of the United States Armed Forces.
