1 AN ACT concerning peddler's licenses for certain veterans and
2 amending R.S.45:24-9.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. R.S.45:24-9 is amended to read as follows:

8 45:24-9. The following persons shall have the right to hawk,
9 peddle and vend any goods, wares or merchandise or solicit trade
10 within this State, by procuring a license for that purpose to be
11 issued in the manner and under the conditions hereinafter in this
12 article prescribed, except, however, the aforesaid right to hawk,
13 peddle and vend any goods, wares or merchandise or solicit trade
14 shall not extend to or include any public beach or public boardwalk:

15 a. Every person who has been honorably discharged or
16 discharged under honorable conditions from the active military
17 service of the United States, who is a resident of this State.

18 b. Every exempt member of a volunteer fire department,
19 volunteer fire engine, hook and ladder, hose, supply company or
20 salvage corps, of any municipality or fire district in this State, who
21 holds an exemption certificate issued to him as an exempt member
22 of any such department, company or corps, and who is a resident of
23 this State.

24 Hawking, peddling and vending hereafter may be regulated by
25 municipal ordinance on public streets and highways.

STATEMENT

32

33 This bill would grant veterans who live in New Jersey and who
34 received a general, under honorable conditions discharge from
35 active military service the right to obtain a peddler's license.
36 Current law only grants this right to New Jersey veterans who
37 received an honorable discharge from active military service. This
38 bill would extend this right to New Jersey veterans who were
39 discharged under honorable conditions.
