SYNOPSIS

Requires boards of education and nonpublic schools to provide law enforcement authorities with copies of blueprints and maps of schools and school grounds.

1 AN ACT concerning school safety and supplementing chapter 41 of
2 Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Each board of education or chief school administrator of a
8 nonpublic school shall provide to local law enforcement authorities
9 a copy of the current blueprints and maps for all schools and school
10 grounds within the school district or nonpublic school. In the case
11 of a school building located in a municipality in which there is no
12 municipal police department, a copy of the blueprints and maps
13 shall be provided to an entity designated by the Superintendent of
14 State Police. A board of education or chief school administrator of
15 a nonpublic school shall provide revised copies to the applicable
16 law enforcement authorities or designated entities any time that
17 there is a change to the blueprints or maps.

19 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

24 This bill requires each board of education and chief school
25 administrator of a nonpublic school to provide a copy of the current
26 blueprints and maps for all schools and school grounds to local law
27 enforcement authorities. Under the bill, if a school building is
28 located in a municipality that does not have a municipal police
29 department, the copies of the blueprints and maps will be provided
30 to an entity designated by the Superintendent of State Police. The
31 bill directs a board of education and chief school administrator of a
32 nonpublic school to provide revised copies to law enforcement
33 whenever there is a change to the blueprints or maps.

35 The requirement that public schools supply law enforcement
36 officials with copies of the school's blueprints and maps is
37 contained in the "Uniform State Memorandum of Agreement
38 Between Education and Law Enforcement Officials" (MOA).
39 Current State Board of Education regulations require all school
40 districts to have a memorandum of agreement with law enforcement
authorities.
