SYNOPSIS

Requires DLPS to establish training program to prepare law enforcement to interact with autonomous vehicles.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As introduced.



1 AN ACT concerning preparing law enforcement to interact with
2 autonomous vehicles and supplementing Title 52 of the Revised
3 Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6 of New Jersey:

7
8 1. a. The Attorney General, in consultation with the
9 Commissioner of Transportation, shall develop or approve a
10 training course and curriculum for law enforcement officers
11 regarding how to safely interact with autonomous vehicles in
12 emergency and traffic enforcement situations. This training course
13 and curriculum shall be reviewed at least every five years by the
14 Attorney General and modified as need may require. The Attorney
15 General shall make the curriculum available to all law enforcement
16 agencies in the State.

17 b. The Attorney General shall be responsible for ensuring that
18 all law enforcement officers complete in-service training on how to
19 safely interact with autonomous vehicles no later than December
20 31, 2020.

21 c. Prior to being appointed to permanent status as a law
22 enforcement officer, an individual shall be required to complete the
23 training course adopted under subsection a. of this section.

24 d. The Police Training Commission shall adopt rules and
25 regulations, pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Act,” P.L.
26 1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), to effectuate the purposes of this
27 act.

28 e. As used in this section, “autonomous vehicle” means any
29 vehicle equipped with technology that has the capability to operate
30 the vehicle without the active physical control or monitoring of a
31 human operator.

33 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

38 This bill requires the Attorney General, in consultation with the
39 Commissioner of Transportation, to establish a training course to
40 prepare law enforcement to interact with autonomous vehicles. The
41 bill requires every law enforcement officer appointed prior to the
42 effective date of this act to complete the training course no later
43 than December 31, 2020. Prior to being appointed to permanent
44 status as a law enforcement officer, an individual is required to
45 complete the training course.

46 While autonomous vehicles are currently prohibited from being
47 tested or operated on public highways in New Jersey, this bill will
48 ensure that law enforcement will be prepared in emergency and
49 traffic enforcement situations when autonomous vehicles begin
50 operating on public highways.
