Makes FY 2020 supplemental appropriation of \$9.5 million to DOH for family planning services.

2 of the State Government and the several public purposes for the  
3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 and regulating the disbursement  
4 thereof," approved June 30, 2019 (P.L.2019, c.150).

6 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and the General Assembly of the  
7 State of New Jersey:

9 1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.2019,  
10 c.150, there is appropriated out of the General Fund the following  
11 sum for the purpose specified:

14 Of the amount herein appropriated for Family Planning Services,  
15 \$9,500,000 shall be allocated, in a manner determined by the  
16 Commissioner of Health, to family planning providers: 1) who  
17 qualified as participating service providers under the Title X  
18 family planning program, authorized by the Public Health  
19 Service Act (42 U.S.C. s.300 et seq.), as established in statute  
20 and regulations on April 1, 2019, and 2) who subsequently  
21 became ineligible for federal funding provided through the Title  
22 X program due to the adoption of federal regulations prohibiting  
23 the use of Title X funds based on the provider's core mission  
24 and not the provider's ability to deliver family planning  
25 services. Eligible family planning providers pursuant to these  
26 provisions shall receive funding amounts as determined by the  
27 Commissioner of Health; however, such amounts shall not be  
28 greater than the average Title X grant amount received by the  
29 family planning provider over the two most recent program  
30 grant cycles, plus any non-recurring Title X grant funds.

32 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
