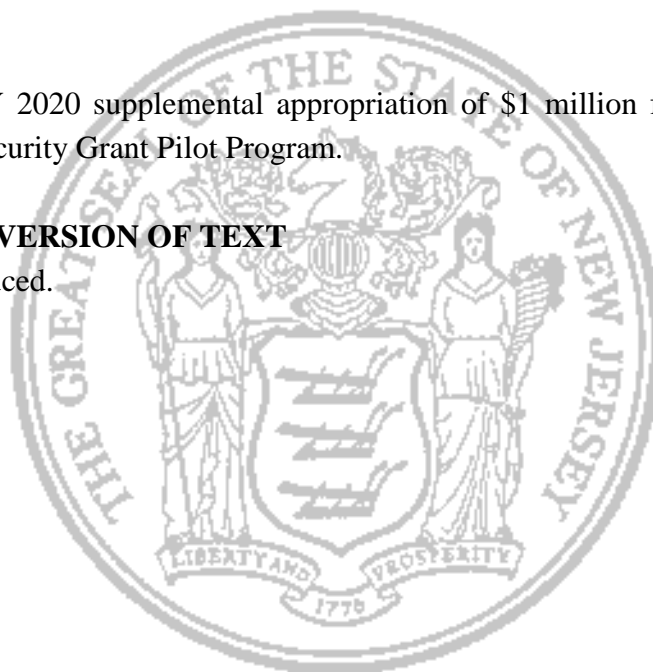

21 This bill supplements the FY 2020 appropriations act by
22 appropriating \$1 million to the Office of Homeland Security and
23 Preparedness for the New Jersey Nonprofit Security Grant Pilot
24 Program. This program provides funding to eligible nonprofit
25 organizations across New Jersey at the greatest risk of terrorist
26 attacks.
