The Senate Transportation Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 2850.

As reported, under current law, the Department of Education (department) is notified by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission if a school bus driver has the driver's driving privileges suspended or revoked. The department then provides this information to the appropriate board of education or school bus contractor that employs the driver.

This bill requires the employing board of education or school bus contractor to provide the department with a statement within 24 hours of the notification of the suspension or revocation, verifying that the school bus driver no longer operates a school bus for the board or contractor.
