1 AN ACT concerning rail passenger service proof of payment and
2 amending P.L.1997, c.357 (C.27:25-5.7).

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 2 of P.L.1997, c.357 (C.27:25-5.7) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 2. The use of a rail passenger service by a person shall
10 constitute an agreement by the person to pay the prescribed fare for
11 the service. A person who has paid the prescribed fare for a rail
12 passenger service and who has been issued proof of payment
13 therefor shall retain that proof of payment while in a pre-paid fare
14 area or on designated rail passenger facilities or vehicles. Proof of
15 payment, whether in printed or electronic form, shall include the
16 price of the fare and the date and time of day the service was
17 purchased and shall indicate on that proof of payment the period of
18 time the proof of payment is valid or the date and time of expiration
19 of the proof of payment.

22 2. This act shall take effect immediately, but shall remain
23 inoperative for 90 days following the date of enactment.

STATEMENT

27

28 This bill requires a rail passenger service to provide purchasers
29 of the service with a proof of payment at the time of purchase. The
30 proof of payment, whether in printed or electronic form, is to
31 include the price of the fare and the date and time of day the service
32 was purchased and indicate on that proof of payment the period of
33 time the proof of payment is valid or the date and time of expiration
34 of the proof of payment.
