Requires pharmacies to provide certain information regarding insulin manufacturer assistance programs.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. a. A pharmacy practice site shall:

8 (1) display a notice concerning insulin manufacturer assistance
9 programs, to be created by the Department of Banking and
10 Insurance, at all points of sale; and

11 (2) provide a pamphlet concerning insulin manufacturer
12 assistance programs, to be created by the department, to an
13 individual purchasing a prescription for insulin and any individual
14 requesting a pamphlet.

15 b. An insulin manufacturer offering an assistance program may
16 inform the department of its intention to be included in the notices
17 and pamphlets.

18 c. The department shall adopt rules and regulations pursuant to
19 the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1
20 et seq.), to effectuate the purposes of this act.

22 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the sixth month
23 next following the date of enactment, except that the Commissioner
24 of Banking and Insurance may take any anticipatory administrative
25 action in advance as shall be necessary for the implementation of
26 this act.
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29 STATEMENT
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31 This bill requires pharmacies to provide certain information
32 regarding insulin manufacturer assistance programs.

33 Under this bill, a pharmacy practice site will be required to
34 display a notice, created by the Department of Banking and
35 Insurance, concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs at
36 all points of sale. A pharmacy practice site will also be required to
37 provide a pamphlet, created by the department, concerning the
38 insulin manufacturer assistance programs to any individual
39 purchasing a prescription for insulin, or to any individual requesting
40 a pamphlet. Insulin manufacturers offering an assistance program
41 may inform the department of their intention to be included in the
42 notices and pamphlets.
