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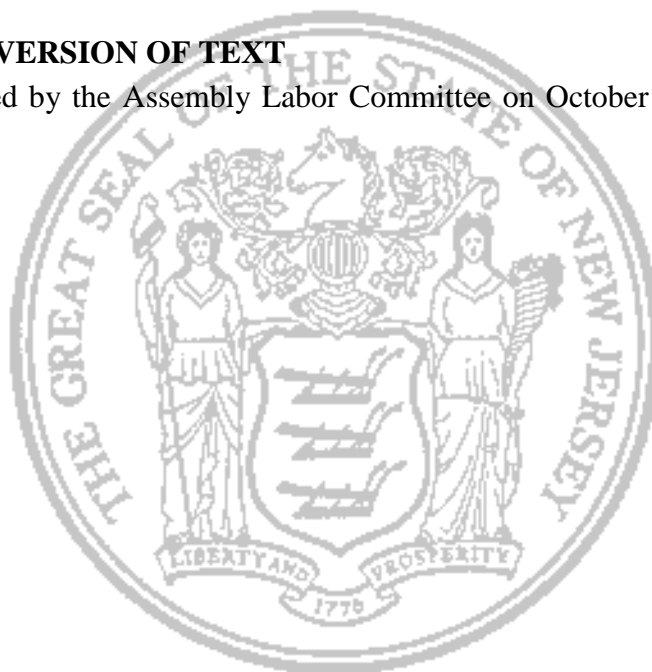

Concerns eligibility for extended unemployment benefits.

1 AN ACT concerning extended unemployment benefits and amending
2 P.L.1970, c.324.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 7 of P.L.1970, c.324 (C.43:21-24.13) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 7. An individual shall be eligible to receive extended benefits
10 with respect to any week of unemployment in **[his]** the individual's
11 eligibility period only if the division finds, that with respect to that
12 week, the individual:

13 a. **[he]** is an "exhaustee" as defined in paragraph j. of section 5
14 of P.L.1970, c.324 (C.43:21-24.11); and

15 b. **[he]** has satisfied the requirements of this act for the receipt
16 of regular benefits that are applicable to individuals claiming
17 extended benefits, including not being subject to a disqualification
18 for the receipt of benefits; and

19 c. **[he,]** for any initial claim for extended benefits effective
20 after September 25, 1982 and before ¹**[November 8, 2020]** June 28,
21 2020¹, has established entitlement for **[his]** the individual's
22 applicable benefit year based on the alternative earnings
23 requirement specified in subsection (e) of R.S. 43:21-4, and was
24 paid wages during the base year of his applicable benefit year which
25 equaled or exceeded forty times his weekly benefit rate; and

26 d. for any initial claim for extended benefits effective after
27 ¹**[November 7, 2020]** June 27, 2020¹, has established entitlement
28 for the individual's applicable benefit year based on the alternative
29 earnings requirement specified in subsection (e) of R.S. 43:21-4,
30 and:

31 (1) was paid wages during the base year of the individual's
32 applicable benefit year which equaled or exceeded ¹**[forty]** 40¹
33 times the individual's weekly benefit rate; or

34 (2) was paid wages during that base year which equaled or
35 exceeded 1 1/2 times the individual's wages paid during the
36 calendar quarter of the base year in which the individual's wages
37 were highest; or

38 (3) had 20 full-time weeks of employment during that base year.
39 (cf: P.L.1982, c.144, s.2)

41 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
