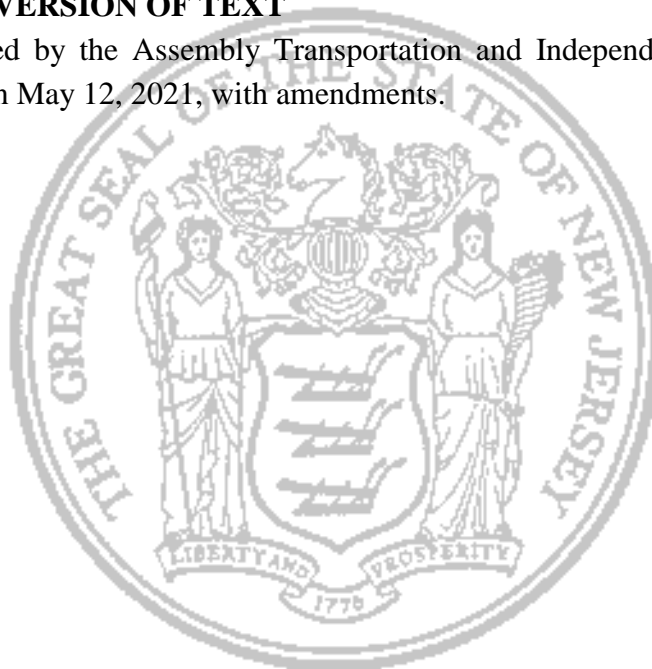

2 Vehicle Commission and supplementing Title 39 of the Revised

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. The New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission shall establish and
9 maintain a toll-free telephone hotline where commission employees, or
10 persons under contract with the commission, are available in real-time,
11 at a minimum, during weekdays between 8:30 a.m. and ¹**[5:30]** 4:30¹
12 p.m., to assist individuals in navigating the commission's website and
13 processing online transactions.

15 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
