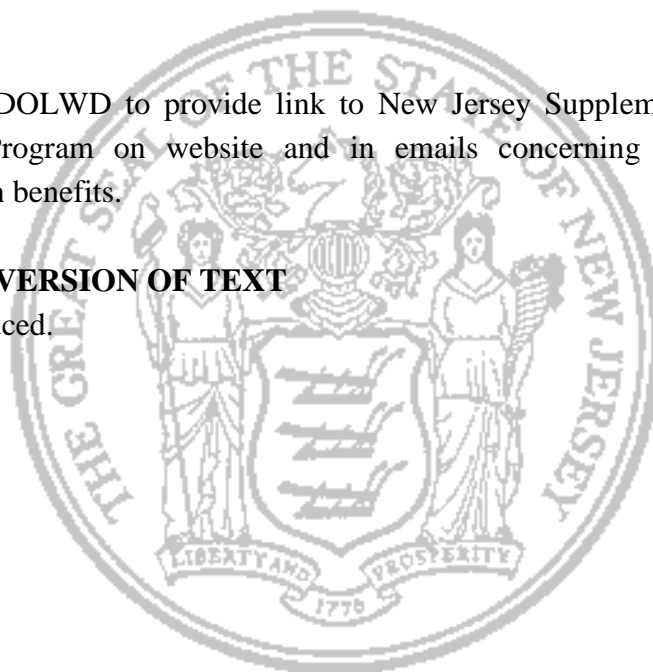

1 AN ACT concerning the New Jersey Supplemental Nutrition  
2 Assistance Program and unemployment compensation benefits  
3 and supplementing chapter 21 of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. The Department of Labor and Workforce Development shall  
9 make available on its website and emails concerning unemployment  
10 benefits a link to the New Jersey Supplemental Nutrition Assistance  
11 Program, as established pursuant to the federal "Food and Nutrition  
12 Act of 2008," Pub.L.110-246 (7 U.S.C. s.2011 et seq.).

14 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
