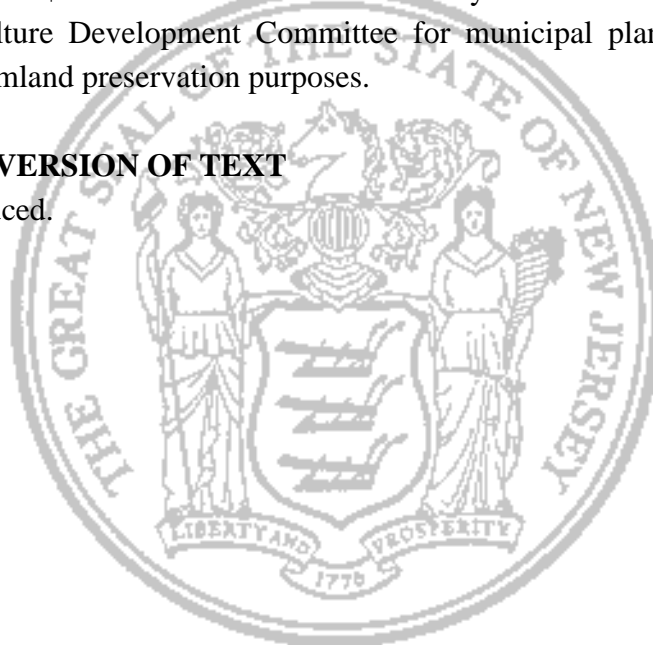

Appropriates \$4.5 million from constitutionally dedicated CBT revenues to State Agriculture Development Committee for municipal planning incentive grants for farmland preservation purposes.

1 AN ACT appropriating \$4,500,000 from constitutionally dedicated  
2 corporation business tax revenues to the State Agriculture  
3 Development Committee for municipal planning incentive grants  
4 for farmland preservation purposes.

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6 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
7 of New Jersey:

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9 1. a. There is appropriated to the State Agriculture  
10 Development Committee the sum of \$4,500,000 from dedicated  
11 corporation business tax revenues pursuant to Article VIII, Section  
12 II, paragraph 6 of the State Constitution in the “Preserve New  
13 Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund,” established pursuant to section  
14 8 of the “Preserve New Jersey Act,” P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-50),  
15 for the purpose of providing municipal planning incentive grants  
16 pursuant to section 1 of P.L.1999, c.180 (C.4:1C-43.1) and  
17 approved as eligible for such funding pursuant to this section.

18 b. The following municipalities are eligible for funding, in  
19 accordance with the rules and regulations of the State Agriculture  
20 Development Committee providing for a municipal planning  
21 incentive grant program, with the monies appropriated pursuant to  
22 subsection a. of this section:

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25 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
26 “Preserve New Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund,” established  
27 pursuant to section 8 of the “Preserve New Jersey Act,” P.L.2016,  
28 c.12 (C.13:8C-50), the sum of \$4,500,000 to implement the  
29 provisions of this act.

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31 3. The expenditure of the sums appropriated by this act is  
32 subject to the provisions and conditions of P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-  
33 43 et seq.), P.L.1999, c.180 (C.4:1C-43.1), P.L.1999, c.152  
34 (C.13:8C-1 et seq.), and P.L.1983, c.32 (C.4:1C-11 et seq.), as  
35 appropriate.

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37 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

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This bill would appropriate \$4.5 million to the State Agriculture Development Committee (SADC) for municipal planning incentive grants pursuant to a program established by P.L.1999, c.180 (C.4:1C-43.1) for farmland preservation purposes.

The funding in this bill is provided from constitutionally dedicated corporation business tax (CBT) revenues pursuant to Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 6 of the State Constitution, approved by the voters of the State in November 2014. The “Preserve New Jersey Act,” P.L.2016, c.12 (C.13:8C-43 et seq.), implements the constitutional dedication of CBT revenues for open space, farmland, and historic preservation. The “Preserve New Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund” was established pursuant to section 8 of the “Preserve New Jersey Act.”

Under the bill, five municipalities will each receive a “base grant” of either \$500,000 or \$1 million, as specified in the bill.

The bill appropriates to the “Preserve New Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund” moneys from the General Fund already constitutionally dedicated to the “Preserve New Jersey Farmland Preservation Fund” for the purpose of making the appropriations required by this bill.

The allocations and projects listed in the bill have been approved by the SADC and the Garden State Preservation Trust.
