1 AN ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION urging the United States Congress to
2 pass the “Retired Pay Restoration Act.”

4 WHEREAS, A 19th Century law requires military retired pay to be offset,
5 dollar for dollar, by the amount of disability compensation received
6 from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs (VA); and

7 WHEREAS, Military retired pay earned by service and sacrifice in
8 defending the United States should not be reduced because a military
9 retiree is also eligible for veterans’ disability compensation awarded
10 for a service-connected disability; and

11 WHEREAS, Retired pay and disability compensation are different types
12 of compensation – retired pay is provided to recognize a career of
13 uniformed service while VA disability compensation is
14 compensation for pain, suffering, and lost future earning power due
15 to service-connected disabilities; and

16 WHEREAS, The “Retired Pay Restoration Act” pending before Congress
17 would permit retired members of the Armed Forces who have a
18 service-connected disability to receive both military retired pay by
19 reason of their years of military service and disability compensation
20 from the VA; and

21 WHEREAS, Service members make countless sacrifices in service to this
22 country and State and should not be forced to forfeit their military
23 retired pay because a 19th Century law reduces their retirement
24 benefit by the amount they receive in disability compensation; now,

27 BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of the State of New
28 Jersey:

30 1. This House respectfully urges the United State Congress to
31 pass the “Retired Pay Restoration Act.”

33 2. Copies of the resolution, as filed with the Secretary of State,
34 shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the General Assembly to the
35 President and Vice-President of the United States, the Majority and
36 Minority Leaders of the United States Senate, the Speaker and
37 Minority Leader of the United States House of Representatives, and
38 every member of Congress elected from this State.

43 This Assembly resolution urges Congress to pass the “Retired Pay
44 Restoration Act.” The act would permit retired members of the
45 Armed Forces who have a service-connected disability to receive
46 both military retired pay and disability compensation from the United
47 Stated Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) for their disability.
