1 AN ACT concerning recalls on vehicles for sale and supplementing
2 Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. A person shall not sell or transfer a motor vehicle without
8 first contacting or accessing information provided by the vehicle
9 manufacturer or the National Highway Traffic Safety
10 Administration to determine if there are any outstanding recalls on
11 the vehicle which have not been corrected or addressed. In the
12 event that a recall is discovered, the recall shall be appropriately
13 corrected or addressed prior to the sale of the motor vehicle.

15 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the seventh
16 month next following enactment.

STATEMENT

21 This bill would prohibit the sale of a motor vehicle with
22 outstanding recalls. Under the bill, a person would not be able to
23 sell a vehicle without first contacting, or accessing information
24 provided by, the vehicle manufacturer or the National Highway
25 Traffic Safety Administration to determine if there are any recalls
26 on the vehicle which have not been corrected or addressed. In the
27 event that a recall is discovered, the recall would have to be
28 appropriately corrected or addressed prior to the sale of the vehicle.
