1 **AN ACT** concerning proof of receipt of the vaccination for the
2 coronavirus disease 2019.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. The State, or any political subdivision of the State, shall not
8 require a private business to confirm that an individual received a
9 vaccination for the coronavirus disease 2019 in order for the
10 individual to be granted entry onto the premises of the business.

12 2. This act shall take effect immediately and expire upon the
13 rescission of Executive Order 103 of 2020, or any extension thereof
14 or any replacement therefor.

STATEMENT

19 This bill prohibits the State, or any political subdivision of the
20 State, from requiring a private business to confirm that an
21 individual received a vaccination for the coronavirus disease 2019
22 in order for the individual to be granted entry on the premises of the
23 private business.
