1 **AN ACT** prohibiting a local government agency from employing
2 certain persons on paid leave from local government agency of
3 another county or municipality and supplementing P.L.1991,
4 c.29 (C.40A:9-22.1).

6 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
7 *of New Jersey:*

9 1. A local government agency, as defined in section 3 of
10 P.L.1991, c.29 (C.40A:9-22.3), shall not employ any person in a
11 full-time or part-time position while that person is on paid leave
12 from a full-time or part-time position with a local government
13 agency of another county or municipality.

15 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
