The Assembly Local Government and Housing Committee reports favorably Assembly Bill No. 1642.

This bill removes the salary "cap" from the positions of commissioner of registration and superintendent of elections, and permits a governing body of a county, by resolution, to set the salary of such persons, provided that the minimum statutory salary requirement is observed. The bill also provides for an annual increase in the budget of the superintendent of elections in counties of the first class.
