with Senate Floor Amendments
(Proposed By Senator ADLER)

ADOPTED: MAY 18, 1998

This amendment provides that a person would be guilty of a crime of the fourth degree if he knowingly engaged in the business of electrical contracting without having a business permit issued by the Board of Examiners of Electrical Contractors and did derive a benefit, the value of which is more than incidental.
